The building, with a newly completed addition, is 7,332 square feet. In 2020 the library had a total operating budget of around \$315,000 and has a collection of over 20,000 items.

The Liberty Center community is located on State Route 109 between State Route 24 and Delta, OH, 32.6 miles west of Toledo.
